Weatherization Assistance Program



The Weatherization Assistance Program (WAP) provides assistance to income eligible households by weatherizing their homes, conserving energy and reducing high utility costs in the process.

The process is easy.

Interested Dallas County residents must complete an application and submit necessary documentation to determine eligibility.

- Door and window repair/replacement
- Solar screen installation
- Heating/cooling unit repair/retrofitting
- Duct work

Clients who need rehabilitation services will be referred to another agency that may be able to provide assistance.

Applicants will be required to submit information to

DCHHS to determine eligibility. Check to make sure that you can provide the following:

Proof of all income earned (or unearned) in the last 30 days for all household members 18 years and older.

Social Security numbers for all household members.

An identification card or driver's license for all household members.
